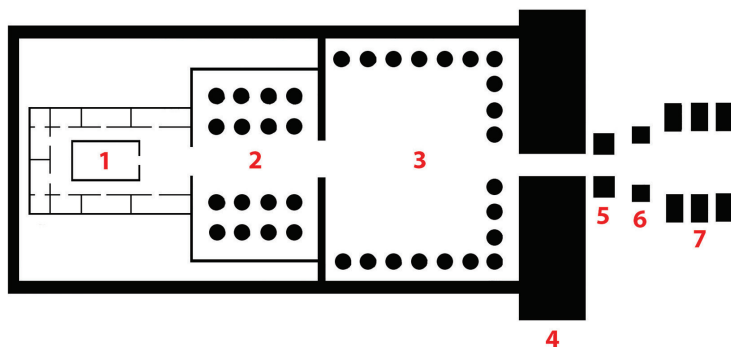
5.) Explain the possible connection between Abraham (Abram) and the Great Pyramid. \_\_\_\_\_
